

Excavations of Herod's Palace on the west side of old Jerusalem adjacent to the Tower of David. Jesus most likely was sent here by Pilate to Herod Antipas of Galilee (Luke 23:6-12). Jesus' case but to do some fence-mending with the Herods But Herod sent Jesus back to Pilate (v. 11) where Pilate passed sentence and symbolically washed his hands of the whole matter.


Right: Stairs of Caiaphas up which Christ was led to trial under the hands of Roman guards.
